1. Title of the Practice: -FUTURA-EARN WHILE YOU LEARN

2. Objectives of the Practice

The "Earn while you learn" programme provides opportunities to the students to earn while they are learning, through part-time jobs. The main objective of the scheme is to develop a student as a multifaceted personality with academic excellence and a commitment to an egalitarian society. It inculcates in the student the idea that no work is big or small and develops a work culture with the right aptitude. Encourage young students to learn about dignity of labor. Prevent students from avoidable distractions and engage them in meaningful, positive activities.

3. The Context

It is not only a platform for students of various streams to financially support their studies but also to gain practical experience which would stand by them in their later career. It will help in a long way in understanding the value of money and money management in future. It will allow the students to decide whether to choose an alternate career or cement their plans about the same career path. Various departments and the students were really inspired, and they have adopted it as self-employment and are earning from their learned skills

4. The Practice

Several programs and workshops were organized during the year:

Exhibition and Sales of Food and Handicraft Products:

An exhibition at the Open-Air Auditorium on December 12, 2023, saw participation from 14 departments. Students displayed and sold food and craft items, making the event profitable and motivating.

Fabric Painting and Printing Workshop: Conducted on September 9-10, 2023, by resource person Smt. Rekha Anil Kumar from Pidilite Fevicryl. Fifty students participated, learning various techniques in fabric painting and printing.

Hands-on LED Assembly & Repair Workshop: Organized on December 1, 2023, by Dr. I. John Berlin, Assistant Professor of Physics at Marthoma College, Thiruvalla. Students were trained in assembling LED bulbs and tubes, which they subsequently sold.

Training Programme on Mushroom Cultivation: A comprehensive session introduced students to mushroom farming, covering everything from preparation to marketing. Mr. Ajay K delivered a PowerPoint presentation on cultivation techniques.

Lotion and Dish Wash Making under the "KARUTHAL" Project: On November 8, 2023, students learned the formulation, production, and marketing of cleaning lotions. This hands-on training provided real-world entrepreneurial experience.

Beautician Training Programme: A three-month course conducted by Smt. Ambili Prathapan equipped students and outsiders with beautician skills. Many participants secured placements in salons and beauty parlors upon completion.
